

STUDENT EXIT SURVEY REPORT (2023–2025)





Objectives of the Exit Survey



- To assess attainment of Programme Outcomes (POs).

- To understand overall student satisfaction with the programme.


Programme Outcome Attainment – Student Feedback

The following colour-coded infographics present student feedback on key Programme Outcomes. Different colours have been used to distinguish response categories clearly. The predominance of positive responses reflects strong attainment of programme learning outcomes.









Key Findings

- A majority of students expressed strong agreement that the programme enhanced managerial and decision-making skills.
- Experiential learning components significantly contributed to analytical and problem-solving abilities.
- Teamwork and communication skills were effectively strengthened through collaborative activities.
- Overall satisfaction with academic delivery and institutional support was high.





Programme Outcome Attainment – Student Feedback (Infographics)




The practical learning experience (Field study/projects/ simulations)







Key Findings
